Checklist Grades 9-12

Dear Parent(s) of Applicant:

Island School's High School is open to students who will be entering 9th-12th grades. Academically talented and socially well adjusted students are encouraged to apply.

Each application is reviewed by an admissions committee and ranked in comparison with other applications for the same grade. Also considered is the fit of the applicant to Island School's program. Applications received by March 1st will receive priority for the upcoming school year. Class size is limited.

A complete application includes the following items:

- Completed Parent Questionnaire;
- Photograph of applicant (not required but highly recommended);
- Application fee of \$35;
- Copy of current and previous years' report cards;
- Copy of recent Standardized Test Results;
- Test results from Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT). (Register for the SSAT and name Island School as a recipient);
- A Two Page Essay written in your own handwriting on the enclosed form;
- Two Teacher Reference Reports. References are required from applicant's current English teacher and an academic teacher (i.e. math, science, history). Provide the teachers with stamped envelopes addressed to Island School;
- Mentor Reference Report. A reference is required from an adult who knows the applicant well (i.e. instructor, coach, clergy). Provide the mentor with a stamped envelope addressed to Island School.
- Parent & Student Interviews: schedule with the Admission Office.

Only completed applications will be considered.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of applicants will be informed of the Admission Committee's decision by April 15th. Applications received after March 1st will be processed as soon as all items have been received.
